C. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) Exclusion Matters

On October 27, 1972, subject voluntarily appeared at INS Office, 20 West Broadway. New York City, New York, with legal counsel, FAUL CHEVIGNY, Attorney At Law, New York City, New York, for the purpose of an exclusionary hearing. Upon her lawyer's motion, the hearing was postponed until November 9, 1972; the subject was presented with exclusion order. On November 9, 1972, the exclusionary hearing was held at INS, 20 West Broadway, New York City, New York. Subject's lawyer filed a motion to suppress all INS evidence regarding the exclusion order due to the fact that the lawyer charged that INS had obtained the evidence by electronic means. On November 17, 1972, after an investigation by the Special Inquiry Section of INS, the subject was again ordered to be excluded. On November 28, 1972, the subject's attorney filed an appeal brief with INS Special Inquiry Section to nullify the exclusion order. INS is currently preparing a counter brief to be filed with the Board of Immigration Appeals which will furnish a ruling after January 1, 1973.




II. ACTIVITIES

A. Miami Conventions Coalition

The Miami Conventions Coalition (MCC) was formed at a national meeting in Washington, D.C., on May 20, 1972, as a coalition of groups planning protest activity at the Democratic and Republican National Conventions.

The subject, a member of the Coordinating Committee of the MCC, is one of the individuals who has the power to make decisions for the MCC.

Of the individuals connected with the anti-war movement going on in Miami Beach, Florida, the subject is considered to be the most victous, the most anti-American, the most anti-establishment, and the most dangerous to the internal security of the United States.



B. Miscellaneous Activities

On September 26, 1972, the subject was observed participating in an anti-war demonstration in the vicinity of the Americana Hotel, New York City, New York, where President RICHARD M. NIXON was attending the Republican Party fund-raising dinner.

Special Agent (SA) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) September 26, 1972

On October 14, 1972, the subject was observed participating in an anti-Vietnam War rally held at the President RICHARD M. NIXON reelection storefront at Madison Avenue and 54th Street, New York City, New York. The rally was held to solicit money for medical aid to Indochina and to support the seven-point peace plan as proposed by the People's Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam.

SA of the FBI October 14. 1972

On October 29, 1972, the subject attended a demonstration and lecture against President RICHARD M. NIXON's peace efforts in Vietnam, held at Hunter College, 69th Street and Lexington Avenue, New York City, New York.



On November 4, 1972, the subject was observed participating at an anti-war rally held at Lewisohn Stadium, City College of New York (CCNY), 135th Street and Convent Avenue, New York, City, New York. The demonstration was against United States foreign policy and for the encouragement of the United States to end "racial discrimination" and "attacks of the working people".

SA of the FBI November 4, 1972

The November, 1972, issue of the "University Review" ("UR"), on Page 27, carried an article written by the subject, in which she reviewed a book entitled "Fire in the Lake".

"UR" is a monthly campus-type newspaper published in New York City for the purpose of displaying articles of current events. The staff of the "UR" is made up of "New Left" activists. The headquarters of "UR" is 2929 Broadway, New York, New York.



In reviewing the book, the subject specifically set forth comparisons of the role of the French Government and that of the United States Government in Vietnam; she stated that both governments were "imperialistic" in nature and set up Vietnamese "puppet governments with the help of collaborators." She delved into the socio-economic aspects of Vietnam and the political and educational reforms of that country.





Weatherman, formerly a faction of Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), controlled the SDS Mational Office from June, 1969, until its closing in February, 1970. Weatherman then entered an underground status and adopted a tactic of "strategic sabotage, with police and military instablations designated as primary targets.

SDS was founded during June, 1962, at Fort Huron, Michigan, and in the 1960's functioned as the leading New Left campusbased student organization in the United States. From a stance of "participatory democracy", the SDS moved to a radicalrevolutionary position. It maintained a national office at 1608 West Madison Street.

Internal factionalism during 1969 produced three main factions: Weatherman, Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM), and Worker Student Alliance (WSA). The Weatherman and RYM no longer consider themselves associated with the SDS. The WSA faction continues to use the name SDS.




