WFO, as well as the Bureau files on those cases.

A copy of this report is also being submitted to INS, NYC, inasmuch as INS is currently conducting exclusionary proceedings against HEMBLEM, a Canadian citizen.

In this regard, [REDACTED] INS Trial Attorney's Office, 20 West Broadway, NYC, provided the following information on 1/31/75.

HEMBLEN is currently in this country as a "lawful resident alien." Upon learning of HEMBLEM's travel to Hanoi and the USSR in May-June, 1971, INS began "exclusionary proceedings" against her to have her legally excluded from the United States. As a part of her defense in this matter, HEMBLEM claimed that she had been the subject of illegal electronic surveillances conducted either against her or those she may have been associated with at the time. To answer these charges, INS in July of 1974 asked the Department of Justice to determine if HEMBLEM had in fact been the subject of any type of electronic surveillance. According to [REDACTED] the Department has not yet responded to this request.



[REDACTED] stated that the subject's attorney had previously filed a motion to enjoin the hearing in this matter, but that within the last two weeks that motion had been withdrawn. This in effect will move HEMBLEM's case from an Immigration Board to the jurisdiction of a court headed by an Immigration Judge. [REDACTED] stated he will keep the FBI notified should any new information in this matter come to light.

The NYO is currently conducting a review of all files in the CAPBOM and PENBOM cases, and will submit in the

In this regard, [REDACTED], INS, NYC, advised on 5/7/75 that HEMBLEN had petitioned that agency for permission to leave New York State and travel to Toronto, Canada. This trip was to begin on 5/20/75, with HEMBLEN's return to NYS on 5/31/75. The purpose of the trip was to be to turn in the thesis HEMBLEN has been working on to the University of Toronto. [REDACTED] further advised HEMBLEN had also asked for permission to return to Canada from 7/16/75 to 7/23/75, for the purpose of defending this thesis. [REDACTED] stated that HEMBLEN would be allowed to make both trips as indicated.

Recipients are reminded that CAPBOM is a criminal investigation to identify and successfully prosecute those persons who planned and carried out the bombing. It is not a security/intelligence investigation which would normally be terminated when an individual's current activities would no longer justify a security investigation.

All offices having a principal suspect residing in its territory who is also the subject of an ongoing security investigation should continue coverage of the suspect in accordance with prior FBIHQ instructions.

Offices having a suspect who has been removed from ADEX and is no longer of a security investigative interest should promptly institute investigation under CAPBOM caption. Such investigation should include, but not be limited to, ascertaining suspect's residence; employment; means of financial support, if unemployed; description and current registration of vehicles owned or frequently used; identity of associates; and current activities. Information developed should be reported to FBIHQ under CAPBOM caption only, with copy of communication designated for suspect's security file.

In our continuing coverage of the above-named suspects, all offices should be particularly alert for signs of a change in attitude or any incident that would indicate an interview of the suspect would be appropriate. None of the suspects are to be interviewed without prior FBIHQ authority. It is recognized that a situation can exist where it would not be desirable to delay the interview in order to obtain FBIHQ authority. In such a situation, the interview should not be delayed. FBIHQ is to be promptly furnished results of such an interview along with the specific details which prompted it.

Prior FBIHQ instructions which in part require submission of monthly summary airtel on each suspect are being modified. Effective upon receipt of this airtel, all offices having a principal suspect residing in its territory are to submit on a 90-day basis, an airtel with succinct summary of results of investigation conducted. WFO as office of origin in the CAPBOM investigation should be furnished copies of all correspondence.

It will be necessary to continue coverage of the principal suspects until such time as the suspect's involvement in or knowledge of CAPBOM is resolved. The communication is to set forth specific, detailed facts developed supporting the recommendation for elimination of the individual as a suspect.

INFORMATION MEMORANDUM

An article appearing in the December 15, 1975, issue of the "New York Post" states that Stewart Albert and Judy Gumbo, whose true name is Judith Lee Hemblen, located an electronic device on December 13, 1975, attached to the inside of a bumper on a 1968 Volvo registered to Hemblen while they were houseguests of well-known attorney William Kunstler. Kunstler, in an interview with newspaper reporters, stated he did not know who was responsible for placing this device on Albert's and Gumbo's automobile "but there's no doubt it's a governmental source." Both Albert and Gumbo stated they believed they were under surveillance by unknown individuals. An article appearing in the December 16, 1975, issue of "The Washington Post" states Kunstler has charged that his home telephone was tapped and the car of two of his legal assistants was fitted with a tracking transmitter.

Albert and Hemblen have been subjects of security investigations by the FBI for a number of years because of their numerous subversive activities. They are both suspects in the Weather Underground (WU) claimed bombings of the U. S. Capitol Building in March, 1971, and the Pentagon Building in May, 1972. They reside in a rural location north of New York City and have in the past few years been in continuous contact with individuals known to sympathize with the WU. It is considered to be part of the support apparatus of the WU. In our continuing investigation of these two individuals and the WU it has been established



that the written communique claiming credit for the bombing of the Banco de Ponce in New York City on June 16, 1975, by the WU was typed on the same typewriter utilized to prepare the communique claiming credit for the bombing of the U. S. Capitol Building.



Because of extensive activities of Albert and Hemblen and their many contacts with known subversives and individuals suspected of or known to be involved in terrorist activities, it was approved at FBI Headquarters on June 22, 1975, that an electronic "beeper" be placed on the 1968 Volvo mentioned previously. This device was installed by our New York Office on August 28, 1975, and removed on September 5, 1975. An additional request to reinstall this device was approved on September 26, 1975, and it was reinstalled on December 11, 1975. This "beeper" which is battery operated, does not monitor conversations, but is strictly a tracking device. It is installed on the outside of a vehicle as in this case and access was not made to the inside of the automobile to aid in its installation.

For your additional information, Albert and Hemblen were subjects of surveillance by the FBI on December 11-13, 1975, as well as on other prior occasions. Kunstler is not now nor has he ever been the subject of an electronic surveillance.

On December 11, 1975, Hemblen and Albert were observed in the company of an unidentified Black male, described as six feet three inches, slender, short Afro haircut, early twenties, dressed in blue jeans and a dark jacket. This Black male boarded a bus at the Continental Trailways Bus Depot on Washington Avenue, in Kingston, New York, at 9:30 AM. Hemblen and Albert returned to their residence and were not observed again until approximately 10:15 AM. At that time they were observed parking in the Kingston Plaza Shopping Center, where they did their laundry and purchased groceries. After buying gas, both returned home. Neither was observed again until 3:30 PM, at which time Hemblen left her residence and proceeded to the Eastern New York Correctional Facility in Napanoch, New York. Hemblen entered the prison facility, and with the exception of one trip to Ellenville, New York, for dinner, she remained there until 10:10 PM. At that time Hemblen drove to a house located on the corner of Church Street and St. Marks Avenue, in Napanoch, New York. At 11:05 PM Hemblen left this residence and returned home.

On December 12, 1975, Hemblen was observed leaving New Paltz, New York, at 1:15 PM. After stopping for groceries Hemblen returned home. Hemblen and Albert were observed again at 3:10 PM, enroute to New York City. Upon arriving in New York City, Hemblen and Albert met two unknown individuals, one male and one female. The male is described as white, six feet two inches, thin, black horn-rimmed glasses, black hair and black beard. The female is described as white, five feet two inches, medium build, attractive. All four ate in a restaurant at 14th Street and Ninth Avenue. After leaving the restaurant, Hemblen and Albert, in the company of the unidentified female walked to 36 Grove Street. The unidentified male boarded a New York City bus. At 10:05 PM, Hemblen, Albert, and this female proceeded to 42 Perry Street, where they entered the building. At 11:30 PM the above three people departed from 42 Perry Street in the company of [REDACTED]. All four proceeded on foot to 36 Grove Street, where they entered. No further activity was observed on this date.

After parking on Broadway at 85th Street, Hemblen and Albert entered several stores within a five block area. Hemblen, Albert, and [redacted] were observed on the street in front of 36 Grove Street near the area of Hemblen's vehicle. No further activity was observed on this date.

As indicated in the attached LHM, HEMBLEM was observed at Napanoch, NY, at the Eastern New York Correctional Facility, on December 11, 1975.

In addition to above, HEMBLEM and ALPERT remain suspects in CAPBOM and PENBOM, are considered national movement leaders, and have historically associated with Weatherman support persons. FBI Headquarters acknowledged the importance of intensified coverage of these subjects and by Bureau airtel 10/28/75, "CAPBOM" set forth instructions to continue intensive investigation of subject's activities.

With these factors present, the mentioned surveillance was instituted.

To assist in the operation of this investigation, an electronic beeper device was placed on the subject's automobile, a 1968 Volvo, bearing NY License 426-ANJ. FBI Headquarters granted authority for NYO to utilize this device. (See Bureau airtel to NY, dated 9/25/75). This device was successfully utilized previously from 8/26/75, to 9/5/75, in a surveillance of HEMBLEM. (Authority to utilize the device at that time is contained in Bureau airtel dated 6/27/75).
