





On February 21, 1956, STEWART ALBERT taught a class at the Free University of Berkeley and used as a text the book, "State and Revolution" by V. I. LENIN and also the "Russian Revolution" by MOREKEAD. In the class, ALBERT attempted to give his own views on the Stalin-Trotsky conflict.



On March 26, 1966, ALBERT was present at a demonstration held in the Civic Center Plaza, San Francisco, California, in protest against U.S. involvement in the war in Vietnam. ALBERT tended a table at which PLP literature was sold and during the demonstration attempted to get some ther PLP members to challenge members of the American Nazi Party who were harrassing the demonstrators. ALBERT became involved in an argument with another individual and was overheard to state that the PLP was opposed to the CP and that CP members were not revolutionists. ALBERT stated that PLP is the only revolutionary party.



Activities in Opposition to the Selective Service System







In an effort to embarrass the Bureau, he would not heritate to resort to cutright lies in any account of such an interview. Also ALBERT is almost always in the company of his wife and numerous others of his type. This situation would provide an excellent opportunity for him to exhibit his contempt and disdain for the FBI in the presence of others and create as embarrassing a scene as he possibly could, including physical confrontation with Agents. He is hostile, arrorant, irrational, and very vocal and would almost certainly not conferate.

For the above reasons, STEWART and JOHN. ALEIPT are not being interviewed, UACB.



Albert indicated that he had been with the May 2nd Movement (M2M) in New York and Scheer contacted officials of M2M in New York concerning the background of Albert. Scheer was told that Albert was "OK" but that caution should be used in dealing with him.

On March 26, 1966, Albert was present at a demonstration held in the Civic Center Plaza, San Francisco, California, in protest against U. S. involvement in the war in Vietnam. Albert tended a table at which PLP literature was sold and during the demonstration attempted to get some other PLP members to challenge members of the American Nazi Party who were harassing the demonstrators. Albert became involved in an argument with another individual and was overheard to state that the PLP was opposed to the Communist Party (CP) and that CP members were not revolutionists. Albert stated that the PLP is the only revolutionary party.

Albert attended a general meeting of PLP members need at 225 Valencia Street, San Francisco. The purpose of the meeting was to hear reports from various PLP clubs and these reports would then be sent to a National Committee meeting in New York.

On May 15, 1965, Stewart Albert attended a meeting of Progressive Labor members held at 2929 - 16th Street, San Francisco. At this meeting a central committee was elected and the members present were broke up into four groups to discuss student activities, committee activities, labor activities and PLP publications.

On September 6, 1966, Mort Scheer, West Coast Organizer of the PLP, remarked that Stevart Albert had quit PLP.







He was advised that this investigation was being conducted at the direction of Mr. FPED M. To all of this, interviewing Agents offered no advice or comment. However, at one point, ALBERT stated the FBI never investigates police departments for their "abusive techniques designed to intimidate Negroes". This point was flatly refuted and it was pointed out to ALBERT the FBI does investigate such allegations under civil rights statutes.

STEWART ALBERT was interviewed at his residence, 1049 Keith Avenue, Berkeley, California, on November 26, 1968. When an attempt was made to advise him of his rights, he stated that he was aware of his rights as had been related to him by the same interviewing Agents at an earlier date.

In connection with the "live pig incident" in Chicago on August 28, 1968, ALBERT stated that since his own arrest by Chicago police for that particular incident had not been resolved, he would not discuss any part of the "live pig incident", except to say that it had been intended as a satirical prank and not meant to stir up the crowd. He would not say how the pig got on the scene, nor would he discuss any person connected with the incident.

When ALBERT was questioned about the snake dance technique being taught, he replied, "What is a snake dance?" He then went on to say that if it is "one of those serpentine things", he did not see anyone being taught that type of thing, nor did he know of anyone being taught karate and defensive tactics. In that connection, ALBERT stated that he was at a loss to understand how anything like a snake dance could be used as an offensive or defensive measure against a police line. He said that he was mildly familiar with karate, and he was certain that if anyone had been teaching karate and defensive tactics it would be time wasted because he knew that little, if any, progress could be made during the short period of time available. He said that in any event he knew nothing about that phase of the demonstrations in Chicago.


He said that the only type of physical activity he saw in Lincoln Park in Chicago was organized calisthenics, and that this was pictured in newspapers and on television.



There have been no instances of the snake dance or "live pig technique" being used in demonstrations in the San Francisco, Oakland or Berkeley areas prior to the August 28, 1968 incident in Chicago.

However, on November 5, 1968, at a demonstration in the Civic Center Plaza, San Francisco, the demonstrators had a live pig called "Pigasus" in a crate on a flat bed truck which served as the speaker's platform. During the time Stewart Albert was speaking, someone urged him to release the big, but Albert declined and said that the pig would be released at the right tactical time. He then told the unidentified man that if that was his "bag", he could release the pig.

Later someone did release the pig, which wandered around for about one half hour and was then recaptured by spectators and brought back to the speaker's platform. The only emotion displayed by the crowd during this time was mild laughter.

The crowd then urged that the pig again be set free and someone again released the pig. Shortly thereafter the pig was captured by the San Francisco Police, who called the San Francisco Humane Society. When the Humane Society representatives arrived, one of the demonstrators ran to the speaker's platform and shouted, "they are arresting our pig". In spite of this attempt to arouse the crowd, only about eight or ten demonstrators came to the nearby area where the pig was caught and quietly watched the Humane Society officers place him in a cage in their truck.

The above was witnessed by a Special Agent of the FBI.

STEWART EDWARD ALBERT was contacted by telephones at his residence, 1049 Keith Avenue, Berkeley, California, to make arrangements for an appointment for interview. ALBERT stated that if the interview was to be a brief one, he would prefer to answer the questions on the telephone.

STEWART ALBERT was advised that he did not have to answer the questions, and that if he did so, the results could be used against him in court. He was also advised that he had the right to a lawyer before answering any question, and that he could discontinue the interview at any time.

ALBERT stated that he was aware of his rights as they had been previously stated to him. He was then additionally advised that the interview was being conducted at the direction of Mr. FRED M. VINSON, Jr., Assistant Attorney General in Charge of the Criminal Division, U.S. Department of Justice.

ALBERT was asked if he recalled the article entitled, "Chicago Retrospective" appearing in the September 6-12, 1968 issue of the "Berkeley Barb" under his by-line. He replied that he did. He was then asked if he was the author of that article. ALBERT replied that inasmuch as he felt that to answer this question was not in his best interests, he would decline to answer and not comment further on the article.

The "Berkeley Barb" of 1/17-23/69 carries an article by ALBERT in which he says he was present at the opening of the trial of the "Oakland Seven", which was 1/13/69 in Oakland, California. In the past two issues of the "Berkeley Barb" articles have appeared under ALBERT's byline which refer to "four" contacts with him by FBI Agents and also that the FBI has been giving me a hard time ever since" the Chicago convention.

In view of the foregoing, it would seem likely that ALBERT is attempting to avoid further contact and has discussed the matter with persons at his former residence and at the "Berkeley Barb", where all are attempting to conceal his whereabouts. Efforts to locate and interview continuing.
